CAREER EXPLORATION TRAINING (CET)

OIC' Career Exploration Training Program can help you develop a pathway to occupational success! In this training you will use technology to learn about your natural skills and strengths and identify career pathways of interest to you. You will be assisted in identifying occupations where you can apply your skills in jobs that interest you. You will experience the fun of Virtual Reality technology as you are immersed into simulations where you can see and experience occupational environments as you use your own hands to complete tasks as you would on the job. The program will also help you connect to local skill training and development resources and/or occupational opportunities to start your career plan. At the completion of this training you will be prepared with a workforce portfolio to help you start your chosen career plan!

Thinking about a career in Warehouse & Logistics?

OIC'S FORKLIFT SAFETY & CERTIFIED LOGISTICS TRAINING

Participants who successfully complete the Career Exploration Training (CET) and have aptitude and interest the Warehousing and Logistic Industry occupations will have the opportunity to enroll in OIC's Forklift Safety Training and Certified Logistics Training (CLT).

Certified Logistic Technicians work in warehouses, distribution centers, and are involved in receiving, shipping, tracking, and processing orders.

Forklift Safety Training is a 4 hour training that teaches you forklift safety rules and forklift operation for general industry. The training covers all topics needed to comply with classroom portion of the training regulations for OSHA forklift certification.

Certified Logistics Training is an 8 week training (120 hour) with two components, Certified Logistics Associate (CLA) and Certified Logistics Technician Training (CLT). CLA training is the first 2 weeks (40 hours) of training and provides you with the knowledge needed to begin working in warehousing. After successfully completing CLA you will continue into CLT training for 6-weeks (120 hours). In CLT you will learn mid-level technical knowledge of Warehousing and Supply Chains and have an opportunity to test for your Certified Logistics Technician (CLT) industry recognized credential.





* ELIGIBILITY is determined after the attached forms are all completed and submitted along with all supporting documentation.

You must thoroughly complete and submit all forms in the packet, eligibility is based on household income and family composition.

You must be determined eligible to receive vocational training at no-cost and be eligible to earn attendance (gas card) and achievement (financial) compensation throughout participation.
